

Sunday School Reports

In 6th grade, we have spent the first half of the year discussing and reading about salvation history. We have learned about key figures like Abraham, Isaac, Jacob, Joseph, Moses, Ruth, David and many other extremely important ancestors of Jesus. These people and their actions helped us to understand how the events of the Old Testament led to Jesus and the New Testament. My students are asking very great and thought-provoking questions, and I am very excited for the rest of the year with them!

In the 7/8th grade: We are learning that God created everything and we are the high point of his creation. We are called to fulfill God's plan. We inherited Adam and Eve's sin.  3. Do not kiss the icons, cross or Gospel Book, just bow and make the sign of the cross.
 4. There is no Antidoron for now.
 5. There is no Coffee Hour for now.
 6. Leave your donations in the wooden box at the beginning of the main aisle.
 Remember, you may be healthy, but other people may have health problems and need to be protected.
